


Fakafo Atoll Profile –

Fakamatalaga e uiga ki Fakafo



Section 1: Background

General information

The *Fakafo Atoll Profile* is one of the profiles prepared for each of the three Tokelauan atolls. These profiles introduce some of the topics covered in the 2006 Tokelau Census of Population and Dwellings.

Each profile provides basic comparisons between that specific atoll and Tokelau as a whole. The profiles do not compare the atolls with one another. If you would like to know more about a topic found in the profile please refer to one of the more detailed census reports. Information on the other census reports can be found at the end of this profile.

Vaega 1: Talaaga

Fakamatalaga fakalauaitele

Ko na fakamatalaga e uiga ki Fakafo ko he tahi ona fakamatalaga kua tapena mo na motu takitahi o Tokelau. Ko ienei fakamatalaga ko ni fakamatalaga muamua agai ki ni ietahi matakupu e takua i te Tuhiga Igoa mo te Faitau Aofaki o Tagata ma na Fale i Tokelau i te 2006.

Ko na fakamatalaga e uiga ki na motu takitahi e tuku atu ai ni fakatuhutuhaga l te va o he motu ma Tokelau katoa. Ko na fakamatalaga e hetuku atu ai ni fakamatalaga l te va o he motu ma he tahi motu. Kafai e manakomia atili ni fakamatalaga e uiga ki na matakupu e takua i loto o tenei pepa, fakamolemole oi tagaki ake ki he tahi ona lipoti auliiili. Ko na fakamatalaga o ietahi lipoti o te tuhiga igoa e maua ite fakaikuga o te pepa tenei.

Final population counts for Tokelau

De jure usually resident population counts

The total usually resident population on census night was 1,466.

This is made up of 1,074 usual residents and 392 usual residents absent on census night.

Usually resident population count present in Tokelau on census night

There were 1,074 people in Tokelau on census night who qualify as usual residents under the specified criteria (excludes overseas visitors).

Section 2: Fakafo population

De jure usually resident population count

Fakafo's population is 483 people.

Thirty-three percent of Tokelau's population lives on Fakafo.

Fakafo's population shown in figure 1 is made up of:

- 370 usual residents who were in Tokelau on census night, and
- 113 usual residents who were away from Tokelau on census night.

Fakafo had a slightly lower proportion of absentees than Tokelau as a whole. 23 percent of Fakafo's population was away from Tokelau on Census Night compared with 27 percent of the overall Tokelau population.

Faitau aofaki o tagata Fakafo e 483.


E toluhefulu tolu pahene (33%) o te faitau aofaki o Tokelau e nonofo i Fakafo.

Ko te faitau aofaki o Fakafo te e fakaali atu i te ata 1 e tupuga mai i na vaega iehei:

- 370 tagata e mahani nonofo i Tokelau ma nae i luga o Tokelau i te po o te tuhiga igoa.
- 113 tagata e mahani nonofo i Tokelau ka nae fafo o Tokelau i te po o te tuhiga igoa.

Ko Fakafo e maualalo malie te pahene o tagata nae i fafo i te po o te tuhiga igoa fakatuhatuha ki Tokelau katoa. E 23 pahene o Fakafo fakatuhatuha ki te 27 pahene o te faitau aofaki o Tokelau katoa.

Usually resident population present in Tokelau on census night age and sex distribution

370 Usual Residents of Fakafo were present in Tokelau on Census Night figure 2 shows the age and sex characteristics of this population. The figure shows that:

- Fakafo has a youthful population – 29 percent of residents are between 10 and 19 years of age.
- There is a relatively low proportion of people in their twenties and early thirties on Fakafo. This appears as a narrowing on the pyramid.
- Fakafo's age and sex structure is similar to that of the total Tokelau population represented in figure 2 by a black line.



E toka 370 ia tagata e mahani nonofo i luga o Fakafo nae i luga o Tokelau i te po o te tuhiga igoa. Ko te ata 2 e fakahino mai ai na vaega tau ki na tauhaga ma na itukaiga tagata o te faitau aofaki o tagata. Ko te ata e fakahino mai ai:

- Ko te faitau aofaki o tagata o Fakafo e talavou – 29 pahene o tagata e nonofo i Fakafo e i te va o te 10 ki te 19 tauhaga te matutua.
- E fai hina maulalo te aofaki o tagata i o latou taki luahefulu mauluga tauhaga te matutua ma te toluhefulu maulalo tauhaga te matutua i luga o Fakafo. E matea i te lauiti i te kalafa i lalo.
- Ko te ata o Fakafo fakatatau ki na tauhaga ma na itukaiga tagata e tali foliga tutuha ma te kalafa o Tokelau katoa e fakahino mai i te laina uliuli i te ata 2.

Section 3: Absentees

Absentees age and sex distribution

Figure 3 shows the age and sex characteristics of the Usual Residents of Fakafo who were absent on census night.

- 27 of Fakafo's 113 absentees were between the ages of 15 and 24 years.
- More males than females were absent from Fakafo (60 males compared with 53 females).
- 12 of Fakafo's absentees were 50 years of age or older.



- E toka 27 o te toka 113 o kilatou nae he i luga o Fakafo i te po o te tuhiga igoa e i te va o te 15 tauhaga ma te 24 tauhaga te matutua.
- E tokalahi atu ia taumalo nae he i luga o Fakafo (60 taumalo fakatuhatuha ki te 53 o tautiti).
- E toka 12 ia tagata e mahani nonofo i Fakafo 50 tauhaga ki luga te matutua.

Reason for absence

113 of the 359 people absent from Tokelau on census night were from Fakaofo.

The most common reasons for absence from Fakaofo were:

- on holiday – 26 percent
- other reason – 20 percent
- schooling / education – 17 percent.

Nationally the most common reasons for absence were:

- on holiday – 31 percent
- schooling / education – 26 percent
- other reason – 15 percent.

- akoakoga – 17 pahene.


Na mafuaaga takalahi e mafua ai te i fafo o te atunuku e aofia ai:

Section 4: Migration

Place of birth

Nearly three-quarters of people living in Fakaofo were born there.

Of the remaining 26 percent of people living in Fakaofo the most common places that they were born are: Samoa (9 percent), New Zealand (6 percent), and another Pacific Island Country (6 percent).



Location 5 years ago

Five years ago Fakaofo's population was living in:

- Fakaofo – 77 percent
- New Zealand – 14 percent
- Samoa – 3 percent.

People from Fakaofo were more likely than people from the other atolls to have been living in New Zealand five years ago and they were less likely than people from other atolls to be living at their current usual residence.



Lived overseas and location lived overseas

164 people living in Fakaofo have never lived overseas for six months or more.

Of the people from Fakaofo who have lived overseas the most common places to live were:

- New Zealand – 89 people
- Samoa – 53 people.

Nofo i fafo ma te nofoaga na nofo ai i fafo

E toka 164 ia tagata e nonofo nei i Fakaofo e heki nonofo lele i fafo o Fakaofo mo he 6 mahina pe mataloa atu.

Ko na nofoaga pito hili te takalahi ona nonofo ai na tino mai Fakaofo e aofia ai ia:

- Niuhila – 89 ia tagata
- Samoa – 53 ia tagata.

Section 5: Social profile

Languages spoken

The three most commonly spoken languages in Fakafo are:

- Tokelauan spoken by 354 people
- English spoken by 214 people, and
- Samoan spoken by 159 people.

Other languages spoken include Tuvaluan and Kiribati.

On Census Night 6 people in Fakafo were too young to talk.

Average number of languages spoken

On average people in Fakafo speak two languages.

The greatest number of languages spoken by any Fakafo resident(s) is 6 languages.

Ethnicity

92 percent of people in Fakafo are full or part Tokelauan, compared with 93 percent of the people from all of Tokelau.

- 75 percent of people in Fakafo said their ethnic group was Tokelauan only.

The next most common ethnic groups were:

- part Tokelauan / Samoan – 8 percent
- part Tokelauan / Tuvaluan – 6 percent.

Highest level of education

- Form 3 or 4 is the highest level of education for 36 percent of people in Fakafo.
- Form 5, 6 or 7 is the highest level of education for 31 percent of people in Fakafo.
- 4 percent of people have a university education.
- The third most common reason for absence from Fakafo was for schooling or education.

Gagana tautala

Ko na gagana takalahi e tolu e talanoa ai ia tagata o Fakafo:

- Tokelau e talanoa ai te toka 354 tagata
- Igilihi e talanoa ai te toka 214 tagata, ma te
- Samoa e talanoa ai te toka 159 tagata.

Ko ietahi gagana e talanoa ai ia tagata ki te gagana Tuvalu ma te gagana Kilipati.

I te po o te tuhiga igoa e toka 6 kilatou i Fakafo koi tamaiiti atili ke tautatala.

Aofaki o na gagana e mafai ke tautala ai

Kafai e vaevae te aofaki o tagata i na gagana e mafai ke tautatala ai ia tagata e maitau e lua ia ia gagana e mafai ke tautatala ai ia tagata o Fakafo.

Ko te aofaki ona gagana pito hili ona lahi e mafai e he tino e nofo i Fakafo ke tautala ai e 6.

Tagatanuku

E tuha e 92 pahene o tagata o Fakafo ni Tokelau katoatoa, fakatuhatuha ki te 93 pahene o tagata uma o Tokelau.

- E 75 pahene o tagata o Fakafo na latou takua ko kilatou ni tagatanuku oioti e o Tokelau.


Ko ietahi tagatanuku e pito hili te takalahi:

- afa Tokelau/Samoa – 8 pahene
- afa Tokelau / Tuvalu – 6 pahene.

Levolo maualuga tau akoakoga

- Ko Fomu 3 pe 4 ko te levolo tau akoakoga pito hili ia ona maualuga kua auhia e te 36 pahene o tagata o Fakafo.
- Fomu 5, 6 pe 7 ko te levolo tau akoakoga pito hili ona maualuga kua auhia e te 31 pahene o tagata o Fakafo.
- E 4 pahene o tagata na ienei ni akoakoga i na iunivehite.
- Ko te mafuaga tona tolu e pito hili ona tokalahi ai ki latou nae i fafo o Fakafo i te po te tuhiga igoa ko na akoakoga.

Marital status

57 percent of people over 15 years of age in Fakaofo are married, and 36 percent have never been married.

Rates of marriage in Fakaofo are very similar to marriage rates in all of Tokelau.

Section 6: Labour Force

Paid employment

In Fakaofo 47 percent of people over 15 years of age worked for pay in the week prior to the census compared with 56 percent of people in all of Tokelau.

Occupation

The most common occupation group in Fakaofo is 'Labourers, Agriculture and Fisheries Workers' with 34 of 104 employed people in that category. This group includes people who have the following occupations:

- foreman
- village worker
- machine operator
- fisherman.

Tulaga tau fakaipoipoga

E 57 pahene o tagata e taki 15 tauhaga ki luga te matutua i Fakaofo kua fakaipoipo, ma e 36 pahene e heki fakaipoipo.

Ko te haohaoa ona fakaipoipoga e fai i Fakaofo e tai tutuha lava ma te haohaoa o Tokelau katoa.

Vaega 6: Kaufaigaluega

Faigaluega totogi

I Fakaofo e 47 pahene o tagata i luga atu o te 15 tauhaga te matutua na faigaluega totogi i te vaiaho kimua o te po o te tuhiga igoa fakatuhuhua ki te 56 pahene o tagata i Tokelau katoa.

Galuega

Ko te itukaiga galuega pito hili te takalahi i Fakaofo ko te 'Leipa, fai fatoaga ma te faifaiva' e tuha ma te toka 34 o te 104 o tagata kua fakavahega e galulue i ienei itukaiga galuega. Ko te vaega nei e aofia ai ia tagata e galulue ina galuega ienei:

- fomeni/pule galuega
- kaufaigaluega a na nuku
- tino faigaluega i na afi/mahini
- tino faifaiva.


The second most common occupation group is ‘Professionals’ with 30 people working in this group. This group includes people who have the following occupations:

- doctor, dentist, nurse or nursing professional
- teacher or teaching professional
- communication, medical, finance, health or police officer.

Ko te itukaiga galuega tona lua e pito hili te takalahi, ko na tino akoakogia fakapitoa, e tuha e toka 30 ia tino e galulue i tenei vaega. Ko te vaega tenei e aofia ai na tino e galulue i na galuega ienei:

- fomai, fomai ifo, teine tauhi tauale pe ko kilatou e galulue fakatauhu tauale
- faikoga pe ko kilatou e galulue fakafaiakoga
- fehokotakiga, falemai, tupe pe leoleo.

Type of unpaid work

People in Tokelau do a wide variety of unpaid work; in Fakaofo the unpaid work done includes:

- 86 percent of people do housework
- 78 percent of people care for their own children, and
- 76 percent of people help with village cleaning.
- Nearly all people in Fakaofo are involved in some form of unpaid work.

In some cases Tokelauan men and women do different types of unpaid work.

- Men are more likely to help with village fishing
- Women are more likely to help with village weaving and care of children from other households.

Itukaiga galuega e he totogia



- 86 pahene o tagata e faigaluega mo te kaiga
- 78 pahene o tagata e tauhi a latou fanau, ma
- 76 pahene e fehoahoani ki fakamamaga o te fenua.
- E toeititi lava ko tagata uma i Fakaofo e aofia i ni galuega e he totogia.

I ietahi taimi ko taumalo ma tautiti o Tokelau e kehekehe na galuega e he totogia e kilatou fakatinoa.

- Ko taumalo e fehoahoani ki na faiva fakamua, ma
- Ko tautiti e fehoahoani ki na faigamea lalaga a te nuku ma te tauhiga o tamaiti a ietahi kaiga.

Section 7: Housing

Type of structure

- The majority of dwellings in Fakaofo are European-style houses (91 percent); there are a small number of houses that are Tokelauan Fale (5 percent) or mixed-style (4 percent).

Number of rooms

In Fakaofo one third of all dwellings have only one room.

- 33 percent of dwellings have one room compared with 39 percent of dwellings in all of Tokelau.
- 43 percent of dwellings have two rooms compared with 32 percent of all of Tokelau.

Itukaiga fale



Numela o na potu

Ko te tahia vae tolu ona fale i Fakaofo e fokotahi oioti te potu.

- E 33 pahene ona fale e fokotahi oioti lava te potu fakatuhatuha ki te 39 pahene ona fale i Tokelau katoa.
- E 43 pahene ona fale e takilua ma te potu fakatuhatuha ki te 32 pahene o Tokelau katoa.

Number of occupants per dwelling

On average dwellings in Fakaofo have 5.8 people per dwelling:

- 26 percent of dwellings have eight or more occupants
- 16 percent of dwellings have five occupants, and
- 12 percent of dwellings seven occupants.

In all of Tokelau dwellings have on average 6.0 people per dwelling.

- 26 percent of dwellings have 8 or more occupants.



Source of personal washing

In Fakaofo the main sources of personal washing are:

- 67 percent of dwellings have a private shower facility – outside the dwelling
- 33 percent of dwellings have a private shower facility – inside dwelling.

Household resources

The most common household resources in Fakaofo are a freezer and telephone as 90 percent of dwellings in Fakaofo own or share ownership of both of these items. Other common household resources include:

- 84 percent have an aluminium boat
- 84 percent have an outboard motor
- 81 percent have a TV and/or video player.



Ko te meatotino e pito hili te takalahi i na kaiga i Fakaofo ko na puha aiha takoto ma na telefon. E tuha ma te 90 pahene ona kaiga i Fakaofo e iei o latou puha aiha takoto pe fai fakatahi foki ma he tahi kaiga. Ko ietahi meatotino takalahi e aofia ai:

- E 84 pahene e fai na vaka apa
- E 84 pahene e fai na afi vaka
- E 81 pahene e fai na TV ma na vitio.

Population count definitions

De jure usually resident population counts

These population counts include the usually resident population present in Tokelau on census night count plus usual residents who are temporarily overseas at the time of the census: including Tokelauan TPS employees based in Apia and their immediate families; and usual residents who are temporarily overseas. Data in Section 2 of this report uses this population count as its base.

Usually resident population present in Tokelau on census night count

Usually resident population present in Tokelau on Census night counts are counts of all people who usually live in Tokelau, and were present in Tokelau on census night.

These counts exclude visitors from overseas and exclude residents who are temporarily overseas on census night. Residents who are in Tokelau and were away from their usual address (i.e. on another atoll) on census night, are allocated back to the atoll where they usually live and form part of the usually resident population present in Tokelau on Census night count of that atoll.

While the other population counts will mainly provide national and atoll population counts, it is the usually resident population present in Tokelau on Census night count that will be used for most of the detailed analysis. This is because we have full information for these respondents as they have been interviewed using the standard census form. Data in Sections 4 to 6 in this report use this population as its base.

Faitau aofaki o tagata e mahani nonofo i luga o Tokelau nae i luga o Tokelau ma fafo o Tokelau i te po o te tuhiga igoa.
