CENSUS 1992

This Census initially means the gathering or collection of relevant information and data which pertain to the following areas:

1. Housing
2. Personage
3. Education
4. Employment

Such information and data collected are analysed to establish the economic, social and demographic conditions to which the island community is subject. For example, we aim to find out present living and housing conditions, establish the rate of growth of the population, determine the constraints on employment, take stock of our educational facilities, programmes, etc.

The analysis of the above will allow for plans to improve upon or develop what we already possess. It will also determine what we would need or do not need. The emphasis of the Census in the final stage is on developmental plans and implementation of such to cater for and accommodate the growth and expansion of the economy for the coming generations.

You are advised that under the Census Act 1973; sections 7 and 9, you are required to answer the questions as directed in the questionnaire in full. You are liable for prosecution on failing to do so.

It is stressed that any information given by you will be treated with strict confidence. Any person found undermining this confidence by divulging any of this information whatever is liable for prosecution facing a penalty charge of \$500 and six months imprisonment.

It is also brought to your notice that to ensure and protect your privacy, there are questions on the questionnaire which can be detached leaving in no way any means of associating and identifying the given information with your person.

For your information and reference, attached overleaf are extracts taken from the Nauru Census Act 1973.

CENSUS ACT 1973

NECESSARY QUESTIONS MAY BE ASKED

7. It is lawful for a person who is concerned with the taking of a census or who is required in pursuance of the provisions of this Act to fill in any return to ask of any other person such questions as may be necessary for obtaining any of the particulars required in pursuance of the provisions of this Act and such other person is required to the best of his ability to give such information.

OFFENCES

9. (1) Any person who -

- [a] refuses or neglects to comply with or acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Act;
- [b] being a person required under this Act to make a statutory declaration with respect to the performance of his duties, makes a false declaration;
- [c] being a person required by this Act to make, sign or deliver any document, makes, signs or delivers or causes to be made, signed or delivered, a false document; or
- [d] being a person required in pursuance of this Act to answer any question, refuses to answer or gives an answer to that question;

is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

(2) Any person who -

- [a] being a persons concerned with taking a census, without lawful authority publishes or communicates to any person otherwise than in the ordinary course of such employment any information acquired by him in the course of such employment; or
- [b] having possession of any information which to his knowledge has been disclosed in contravention of this Act, publishes or communicates that information to any other person;

is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine of five hundred dollars and to imprisonment for six months.
