

Solomon Islands

2011 Fact Sheet



The **2011 Solomon Islands GSHS** measured alcohol use; dietary behaviours; drug use; hygiene; mental health; physical activity; protective factors; tobacco use; and violence and unintentional injury.

The 2011 Solomon Islands GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades Std 6, Forms 1-3. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in grades Std 6, Forms 1-3 in Solomon Islands. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate. The school response rate was 97%, the student response rate was 88%, and the overall response rate was 85%. A total of 1421 students participated in the Solomon Islands GSHS. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet. For comparison purposes, only students aged 13-15 years are included in the analyses for this fact sheet.
